Some very positive news in NSW in the response to COVID-19, but as the Premier says, we must remain vigilant. In accordance with NSW Health advice, parents and carers are reminded that not to send children to school if they are unwell, even if they have the mildest of flu like symptoms. All students are expected to be at school unless they are unwell or they have a current medical certificate stating that they are unable to return to school.
